

Springs Operating Policy No. 7 Racquet Club Facility

The Springs Racquetclub Facilities are intended solely for the use of Springs owner/resident and accompanied guests for tennis recreation and related social activities as well as authorized tennis teams and those receiving lessons from the Springs Tennis Pro. Court reservations are recommended. The facility is open from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. each day.

Access is gained through the use of an access/proximity card. The name of each resident using the facility is recorded through use of this access card. Please report any lost or stolen access cards immediately. The Racquetclub facility is under constant video surveillance.

Access cards, which work both the Pool / Health Spa Facilities and the Racquetclub Facility, are available at a cost to legal property owners. Property owners may authorize their tenant to purchase access cards in writing or by a completed amenity authorization form. This written authorization must be submitted to the SCA Business Office. It is the owner's responsibility to secure the return of and notify the Springs so the cards may be deactivate. Access cards cannot be issued if the property owner's account is delinquent.

The cost of an access card is set forth in the current SCA schedule of fees.

The SCA Board of Directors will appoint a Tennis Committee each year composed of five to seven members of the Association. The use and operation of the Racquet Club will be governed by the Tennis Rules and Regulations adopted by the committee and approved by the SCA Board of Directors. These rules and regulation may be amended from time to time by the SCA Board of Directors. Tennis rules and regulations are posted at the facility and all persons utilizing it must abide by these procedures.

Courts are for tennis use only and court attire shall conform to normally accepted tennis wear. Shirts shall be worn at all times. Tennis shoes and rubber-soled shoes (excluding cleated soles) must be worn on the courts.

Children under (12 years of age are not permitted inside the chain link fence surrounding the facility unless under direct adult supervision. Pets/domesticated animals are not permitted in the area at any time.

A part-time Tennis Prop is contracted by the Association to manage the day to day operation of the facility. The Pro is paid by those who utilize his/her services for instruction.

The restroom facilities are kept locked at all times and are accessed by the access card.

The SCA is not responsible for the loss of any valuables in the Racquet Club / Tennis Facilities.

Residents and guests utilizing the Racquet Club / Tennis facilities are to treat the facilities and equipment with due care. Please report any damage or vandalism to security immediately. The SCA reserves the right to deny the use privileges of these facilities.
