Volunteers are a community's biggest resource, and the SCA is no different. With almost 900 properties and as many varied interests and areas of expertise, our residents are our greatest resource.

Many of you have voiced opinions regarding the fences, the undergrowth around the Spring, the state of the Clubhouse, etc. Although we as the Staff of the SCA hear your concerns, there is only so much time in each day and we are not too proud to ask for help.

The betterment of the SCA will only help all of you by improving property values and raising community spirit.

SO, COME ONE, COME ALL (Singles, Families, Groups, etc.), AND HELP OUT IN YOUR COMMUNITY.

If you'd like to volunteer, please come to the SCA office and fill out a request form. Let us know what service you would like to provide, and Management will give approval and materials for your efforts. For example if you'd like to paint fences, we will provide paint and some direction where to start, or if you would like to help out in the nice air-conditioned business office, we will provide you with workspace and a filing cabinet that is in disarray.

Now, here are some simple rules to follow for The SCA Volunteer Program:

1. Please come in to the SCA business office (or the Guardhouse) and fill out a Volunteer Request Form.
2. Submit your specific request for Volunteering (i.e. painting, filing, cleaning, etc.) to Management for written approval (which, in some cases may also be required from the ACC).
3. Keep in mind that if your request involves a sub-association, that you must obtain their approval first (in writing) before approaching the SCA.
